

Warning about "deep fake" AI posts on social media - Vatican News is warning about the circulation of "deep fake" videos and false social media posts purporting to feature statements by Pope Leo XIV. Be wary of accepting questionable materials at face value and carefully check sources. All the speeches and messages Pope Leo XIV has given since becoming pope on May 8 are available on the Vatican website, which should be checked before sharing supposed quotes and videos. The recently-revised Vatican website — www.vatican.va — offers all papal texts, including the texts of the Holy Father's video messages, in multiple languages.
