

Lenten 40

Relay run on the eve of Holy Week connects the physical and the spiritual: This year's Lenten 40 will be held **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday, March 28, 2026**, starting from the Cathedral of the Holy Family in Saskatoon (corner of Attridge Drive and Forestry Farm Drive, 123 Nelson Road) featuring a 41.9-km course tackled by teams of two or four.

As they run, participants are encouraged to *"meditate on the suffering of Jesus and think of the Via Dolorosa (the path Jesus took on his way to the crucifixion, often translated to the way of suffering) ... It's about showing up and giving it all to God."*
